CATEGORISATION OF CANDIDATES:

The candidates appearing for Intermediate (TOSS) Public Examinations are categorized as follows:

- CATEGORY-1: Candidates admitted online during 2021-22 (i.e., fresh admissions of the academic year) are treated as Category-1.
- CATEGORY-2: Candidates admitted during previous years i.e., 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 & 2020-2021 and appeared for Intermediate (TOSS) Public Examinations but failed are treated as Category-2.
- CATEGORY-3: candidates admitted during previous academic years i.e., 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 & 2020-2021 and appearing for the Intermediate (TOSS) Public Examinations for the first time are treated as Category-3
- CATEGORY-4: Candidates admitted during the academic year 2021-22 (fresh admissions of this academic year) but having only one year gap after passing SSC and are eligible to appear to a maximum of 4 subjects only, are treated as Category-4.
- CATEGORY-5: Candidates who have appeared for Intermediate (TOSS) Public Examinations and passed in some subjects and failed in some subjects and desires to improve their performance in any passed subjects are treated as Category-5.
- CATEGORY-6: Candidates who have passed (all subjects) Intermediate (TOSS) Public Examinations and desires to improve his performance by cancelling his previous performance. The latest performance holds good either pass or

fail. The original pass certificate and Migration cum Transfer Certificate of TOSS shall be surrendered to TOSS along with under taking of the candidate.

CATEGROY-7: Failed candidates of Categray-5 who have already availed the improvement chance. And not allowed to avail improvement chance in future.

CATEGORY-8: Failed in 6th subject (addl. subject) and Passed in all the main five subjects and pass certificate also issued to the candidates. These candidates appearing only for the 6th subject. The main five subject codes are kept blank.

ALL THE AI-COORDINATORS ARE REQUESTED TO NOTE THAT, **ONLINE ENRS WILL BE HOSTED IN THE WEBSITE.** All the AI Coordinators are requested to instruct the candidates to approach **TS Online /Meeseva centres in Telangana State** for payment of examination fee.

An asterisk (*) mark on the subject code denotes that the candidate already passed in that subject and no need to appear for the examination. Subject codes without Asterisk Mark, indicates failed subjects. The provision of selection of subjects (to appear for the examination) is given to the subjects in which the candidate failed only. Total number of failed papers is indicated under the heading SUB.CNT (subject count).

TOC CANDIDATES:

All the AI Coordinators are requested to submit the Intermediate original failed marks memos (i.e. Regular stream of Intermediate failed candidates memo) submitted by the candidates who are admitted in the academic year 2021-22 and opted for TOC to the District Educational Officers on or before 02.05.2022 along with enclosed proforma. (Annexure-II).

PH CANDIDATES:-

All the AI Coordinators are requested to submit the Xerox copy of Medical Certificate issued by the District Medical Board duly attested by the District Educational Officer in respect of the PH candidates who are admitted in the academic year 2021-22 to the District Educational Officer on or before 02.05.2022 along with enclosed proforma. (Annexure-I & Application form).

6TH ADDITIONAL SUBJECT:

- i. The 6TH Additional subject if opted by the candidate is shown separately in the ENR under heading 6TH SUB.
- ii. Fail or pass in the 6th Additional subject shall have no impact on the chosen five subjects pass.
- iii. **If the candidate fails in any one subject of the chosen five subjects, the result will be declared as failed, irrespective of his pass in 6th additional subject.**

IMPROVEMENT OF PERFORMANCE :

There is **no provision of improvement** to the candidates who have **passed in all the subjects**. If any candidate wants to improve his performance, **he can do so by duly cancelling the earlier performance**. In such case the marks in the

latest performance only holds good either passed/improved/failed. Such candidate has to submit the following apart paying examination fee for all subjects including practical papers if any. Without submitting the following they are not eligible to pay the examination fee.

- a. Surrender the original Intermediate (TOSS) Public Examination Pass Certificate and Migration cum Transfer Certificate issued to the candidate for cancellation.
- b. Declaration in the proforma enclosed.

The AI- Coordinators are informed that ENRs(of pass certificate holders) are not hosted online. **AI-Coordinators are requested to prepare Manuscript Nominal Rolls in respect of these candidates (Category-6) separately and submit MNRs along with original pass certificates to the District Educational Officer.**

- 1. The Candidate who had failed in some subject and passed in other subjects are permitted to improve their performance in the subjects passed. But this improvement chance can be availed by the candidate only once during his tenure of 5 years/ 9 examinations before he passes in all subjects and the candidate appearing for improvement comes under **Category-5**.

MALPRACTICE CASES UNDER CATEGORY-2

The ENRs in respect of candidates who are involved in Malpractice in Intermediate (TOSS) Public Examinations, Oct, 2019 and are permitted to appear for the Intermediate (TOSS) Public Examinations, May/June, 2022 are included in the ENR duly cancelling their entire performance of Oct, 2019. Hence, these candidates have to appear for all the subjects.

The ENRs of the candidates who were involved in Malpractices in the earlier examinations and eligible to appear for May/June, 2022 examinations are also hosted in online.

I. GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF NRS IN THE DEOS OFFICE BY THE AI- COORDINATORS:

- a. Print out of 'Fee paid list' of regular and supplementary candidates separately.

- b. Print out of Fee not paid list of regular and supplementary candidates separately
- c. AI wise summary statement of Regular and supplementary candidates.
- d. TOC list along with original second year intermediate failed marks memo (2021-2022). **Failure to submit the original certificate entails cancellation of TOC facility.**
- e. PH list along with application of the candidate and **Xerox copy of the Medical Certificate issued by the District Medical Board attested by the DEO.** Failure to submit the Xerox copy of the Medical Certificate attested by the DEO entails cancellation of PH and treating as general candidate.
- f. Corrections duly carried out in the fee paid and not paid list with regards to the Bio-data of the candidate as per the SSC pass certificate, enclosing the Xerox copy of the SSC certificate, Xerox copy of ration card in case of mothers name in support of the corrections. Corrections carried out without supporting documents shall not be accepted. No further correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.
- g. Change of subject codes in the ENR are not accepted.
- h. Subject for which fee paid shall not be exchanged with the subjects for which fee is not paid.
- i. No corrections/alterations are permitted in subject codes.
- j. Theory subject code wise/ medium wise statement of Question Paper requirement.
- k. Practical subject code wise/ medium wise statement of Question Paper requirement.
- l. The following documents are to be submitted in respect of candidates who have passed in all the subjects but appearing for improvement by cancellation of earlier performance.
 - i. Manuscript Nominal Rolls
 - ii. Declaration of the candidate
 - iii. Cancelled pass certificate and Migration cum TC with signature of the candidate duly attested by the AI-Coordinator.
 - iv. Payment of examination fee.(Examination fee @Rs.250/- per theory paper and @ Rs.200/- per practical paper) in the form of DD payable to the Director TOSS, Hyderabad should be submitted.

All the AI-Coordinators may be informed to submit the fee paid particulars of the candidates in the above procedure.

All the AI-Coordinators are requested to give wide publicity in this regard and guide the candidates of Telangana State to the **TS Online** /Meeseva centres for payment of examination fee. Further, they are informed that **challan/DD payment of examination fee is not accepted** as the online ENR cannot be updated. Only payments at TS Online/Meeseva centres are accepted. 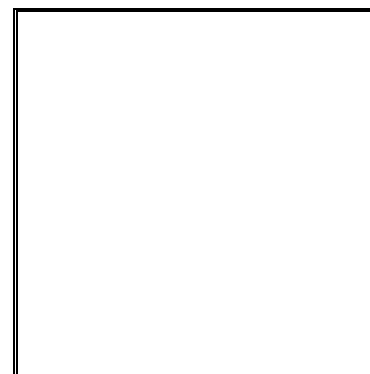
